MAKING A SONG USING EVERYDAY MATERIALS – EXERCISE

TUNE : 'THIS OLD MAN'

PROPS: TOY ANIMALS

This spotty cow

TUNE: ?

PROPS: see verses

Bang, bang Etc.

There was a girl who had a chicken

And this is what it sounded like

Cluck, cluck, cluck..... etc.

TUNE: WHEELS ON THE BUS

PROPS: see verses

The ribbons in my hands go whoosh ...

The pen on my nose goes Tap...

The bricks falling down go Crash.....

The cars on the mat go Brum.....

The water in the tray goes splash...

All day long.

TUNE: I'M A LITTLE TEAPOT

I'm a firefighter brave and strong

Climb the ladders, they're so long

When you see a fire, hear me shout

Use your hosepipe and put it out

TUNE: WHAT SHALL WE DO WITH THE DRUNKEN SAILOR

PROPS: Playdough

*Poke, poke, poke the playdough (3 times)

Early in the morning

*squash; bang' stretch' pat; roll; cut; pinch; tap; twist

TUNE: WHAT SHALL WE DO WITH THE DRUNKEN SAILOR

PROPS: see verses

What can you do with a magic wand? (3 times)

Early in the morning.

Wave, wave your wand

Turn into a ... lion

Roar, Roar, Roar like a lion

Turn into a ... frog

Jump, jump jump like a frog
