

Sonic Minds: Session Observation Framework

To be completed by music leaders, evaluators and other observers towards the beginning, middle and end of the project. This is to document any in-the-moment observations, and also any indicators of change in the young people you notice during the sessions. This is a flexible framework for noting observations: there is no requirement to complete this whole form. Some of these indicators may not be applicable at all. Just make notes of what it is that you do observe, even if minimal. The second half of this form is an opportunity for any general notes, reflections, comments, thoughts you may have.
